

- Training Date: October 10 & 11, 2017
- Number of attendees: 50
- Waitlist: 8
- Topics covered included: sampling techniques appropriate for collecting non-potable water, 40 CFR 136, and chain of custody requirements.

Trainee Evaluations

- 1. Did this workshop meet your expectations?
- 37 Responses
- 73% of respondees answered "yes."
- 27% answered "no":
- Looking for practical work for lab analysis (less classroom work) (3 responses)
- Was not geared towards surface water
- This class was more advanced than I anticipated; I wish it could cover some entry-level terms
- Videos of sampling would have been beneficial
- Expected this workshop to cover different sampling techniques, didn't expect so much emphasis on record keeping

Trainee Evaluations

2. How could this workshop be improved?

- More visuals (videos, pictures)
- More hands-on, less class time
- Teach to the requirements of the audience (not just samplers and inspectors)
- Cheaper cost of materials
- Provide all documents to attendees/online access
- Visit a wastewater treatment plant
- Discuss troubleshooting issues that occur in the field

- Incorporate more state specific regulations
- More demonstration of specific equipment use
- Have two trainings one for entry-level and one for advanced
- Case studies, problem-solving
