

Fats, Oils & Grease

Fats, oils and grease (FOG) found in food ingredients such as meat, cooking oil, shortening, butter, margarine, baked goods, sauces and dairy products can cause the sewer lines in homes and streets to back up if it is not disposed of properly.



Frying a turkey for the holidays?

Schedule a free <u>Household Hazardous Waste collection</u> for large quantities of fats, oils and grease. Curbside collection is available to all residents.

Expensive Repairs

FOG that is poured down the sink drain will cling to the insides of pipes and the sewer system, and over time can build up and block pipes completely. If wastewater can't move freely through pipes and out into the sewer system, it can back up into your home and can cause unsanitary conditions and damages that can be expensive to repair.



Why You Should Be Concerned

- Pouring fats, oils and grease down the drain may clog your pipes and back up sewage lines. Sewage back-ups can damage personal property, and that can be expensive for the homeowner.
- The City of McKinney spends around \$300,000 a year to clean out blocked pipes within the public sewer system.


What You Can Do

- There are several ways to dispose of fats, oils and grease that won't impact the pipes in your home, the sewer lines or the environment,
- Let fats, oils and grease cool to room temperature in pots and pans. Then pour it in a container and throw the container away in the trash.
- Before you wash pots and pans, wipe the fats, oil and grease with a paper towel and toss it into the trash.



American Bio Source to take over Texas biodiesel plant at Denton landfill

In Texas, American Bio Source will take over the biodiesel plant at the landfill in Denton, bringing production back online. American Bio Source has been collecting used cooking oil for biodiesel production since 2010 and sought to relocate to the landfill.

The facility is the first in the country to power biodiesel production using landfill methane. The facility was opened in 2005 but closed in 2008 when the California company that ran it suddenly shut it down and the city later sued it for breach of contract. The city has pledged to buy at least 300,000 gallons to run its fleet under the previous agreement before the shutdown but has since converted part of the fleet to natural gas.
