2. Three Toolkits to Leverage for Your Litter Cleanup Events and Programs.

Crysta Guzman, Environment and Development Planner II, NCTCOG, will discuss the litter cleanup toolkits developed as part of NCTCOG's Trash Free Texas project. First, she will provide an overview of the Community Cleanup Challenge Toolkit and the Local Government Trash Reduction and Education Toolkit. Then, details will be provided on the soon-to-beavailable, Recreational Cleanup Toolkit, which provides resources to assist communities and other entities interested in litter cleanup events that include a recreational component.

- 3. Know What to Throw (KWTT) Campaign Discussion.
  - a. MVPs (Most Valuable Posts). NCTCOG will present the social media posts that resonated the most with our regional audience over the past quarter.

    - September KWTT Posts Do recycle paper. Do NOT recycle takeout containers, plastic utensils, and plastic bags.
