## FY22 Special Project Update

Non-structural Stormwater BMPs can be broken into several categories:

- Public Education
  - Outreach and education campaigns, etc.
- Planning and Management of Developing Areas
  - Site design, vegetation control, green roofs, LID, etc.
- Materials Management
  - Housekeeping practices
- Street/Storm Drain Maintenance
  - Street cleaning, road/bridge

- maintenance, stormdrain maintenance, storm channel/creek maintenance, etc.
- Spill Prevention and Cleanup
- Illegal Dumping Controls
  - Stormdrain markers, HHW collection, used oil recycling
- Illicit Connection Controls
  - IDDE programs, failing septic systems and SSOs
- Stormwater Reuse
