## FY22 WORK PROGRAM UPDATE

- FY2022 Special Project: Videos and teacher support materials, that are TEKS aligned, covering stormwater education for schools on prioritized topics:
  - 1) Why is stormwater important (stormwater protection)
  - 2) Yard Waste, lawn care, and pesticides
  - 3) What to look for (around town) and how to report issues
  - 4) Pet Waste
  - 5) Native Plants
- Working through the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) standards across our target grades. Efforts complicated by wide range of grades.
- May need to consider scaling back grade range so can provide resources better tailored to students and teachers.
  - Currently attempting to target grades 5<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup>



#### FY22 WORK PROGRAM UPDATE TEKS ALIGNMENT OVERVIEW

For Elementary:

- 4<sup>th</sup> Grade: aligns to three suggested topics.
  - Lens to consider:
    - For <u>stormwater protection</u> look through how water cycles, using stream tables to show how pollution enters system; water as a renewable resource
    - For <u>native plants</u> consider structures to help plants survive and how soil types determine which plants grow best
    - For <u>what to look for/report</u> consider human modifications to environment and consequences



#### FY22 WORK PROGRAM UPDATE TEKS ALIGNMENT OVERVIEW

For Secondary:

- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade aligns to topics of <u>stormwater protection</u> and <u>what to look</u> <u>for/report</u>, but not native plants.
  - Lens to consider:
    - Effects of human activity on groundwater and surface water and consequences.
- High School aligns best with Environmental Science for topic of <u>stormwater</u> <u>protection</u> only. This class can be taken at multiple grade levels.
  - Lens to consider:
    - Causes of pollution, impacts and conservation





# TREE COOPERATIVE PURCHASE

- NCTCOG Managed Tree Cooperative Purchase Program
  - Open to local governments in region
  - Two phases:
    - **Replacement Program:** source trees **now** to replace damaged stock (local govt. owned/managed properties)
    - Planting Program: source trees for local govt. use and/or residential giveaway programs in years thereafter
- Next Steps:
  - Focus Group to meet on May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 11:00 am. Will help identify which tree species and sizes should be specified in RFP
  - Issue RFP summer 2022
  - Gather program commitments from local governments
    - Replacement Program: how many trees (of each type) needed now
    - Planting Program: how many trees (of each type) needed each year after
