Both discussion items were discussed and described in summary below.

3. Post-Construction Stormwater Management.

Discuss challenges, experiences, and resources.

The summary of challenges in compliance with the TCEQ MS4 General Permit included: passing a post-construction ordinance, enforcing the requirement of Operations & Maintenance Plans, long term maintenance obligations, and insuring staff were trained on inspecting BMPs. The majority of cities expressed issues with passing stormwater ordinances due to their city management's perception of creating additional upfront costs for developers, and general lack of clear guidance from TCEQ due to lack of prescribed standards. Those cities that already have post-construction language in place say that they are having difficulty having private property owners keep up with long-term maintenance of stormwater BMPs. All cities stressed the need for more details, standards, and baselines from TCEQ. Another request was to share best practices and documents that help guide the inspection process for city staff and private developers. It was also noted that resources should place emphasis on the importance of how temporary BMPs are installed and how that impacts long-term effectiveness. NCTCOG referred the group to the existing iSWM resources, especially the recommendations for Operations and Maintenance Plans, at www.iswm.nctcog.org.

4. Next Steps.

Discuss next steps for Construction/Post-Construction Task Force.

NCTCOG will survey cities in the region to create a benchmark of existing construction/post-construction ordinances, operations and maintenance plans, and inspection checklists. NCTCOG will schedule 30 minute to 1 hour phone interviews with the cities to discuss their existing regulations and needs.

NCTCOG will use this information, plus conduct additional research, to develop a model post-construction ordinance and create a package of construction/post-construction resources for cities in the region. NCTCOG will also continue reaching out to TCEQ for clarification on post-construction regulations.

The goal is to have the document reviewed by the Regional Stormwater Management Coordinating Council, Integrated Stormwater Management Implementation Subcommittee (iSWM), and TCEQ. The group agreed that they will need the ordinance by Summer 2018 in order to have it reviewed and approved by their respective City Councils.

OTHER BUSINESS AND ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION

5. Roundtable Discussion. Discussion of activities within individual jurisdictions and other topics as time allows.

Flower Mound: Conducting in-stream sampling and doing education outreach to grades 2 and 7.

Cedar Hill: Wrapping up dry weather screening.

Dallas: Waiting for new permit.

Plano: Stormwater ordinance has gone to their council for approval.

Addison: Began implementing water quality sampling during dry weather screenings of BMPs to track effectiveness. Conducting education outreach.

Carrollton: Has begun conducting post-construction inspections. Writing their annual report.

Mansfield: Conducting post-construction inspections. Drafting on annual report. Working on post-construction/water quality with enforcement mechanism.

Denton: Conducting Denton Stream Clean. Some city departments being restructured.

Cleburne: Waiting for new permit.

Fort Worth: Currently drafting their Environmental Master Plan. Final draft should be ready in December. Will be have public meetings soon.

NTTA: Getting ready to draft their annual report. Waiting for new permit.

Lewisville: Stormwater fee has been approved by their city council.

DFW Airport: Will be getting a new software to help with construction inspections and maintenance.


