## Air Quality



### Air North Texas

The City of Cedar Hill is a proud partner with [Air North Texas](#), a regional public awareness campaign and partnership that seeks to improve air quality in North Texas. The campaign was formed by the North Central Texas Council of Governments with support of a task force made up of government agencies, nonprofit organizations, transportation authorities and others. Air North Texas offers all North Texans, including individuals, businesses and governments, resources related to improving air quality. Ten counties in North Texas fall under nonattainment for the pollutant ozone, according to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). North Texas must meet ozone emissions standards as set by the EPA or face federal sanctions. The Air North Texas campaign was created to help alleviate the air quality problem in our region.

### Air Quality Index

Become familiar with the [Air Quality Index \(AQI\)](#) to better understand the severity of air pollution and related health impacts. The AQI is used for reporting daily air quality levels. Colors indicate how polluted the air is and how to protect your health.

Inhaling ground-level ozone is especially dangerous for people who have asthma or respiratory problems, and they may experience increased frequency of asthma attacks and health care needs. Young children may also be at risk for developmental problems associated with ozone exposure. People without respiratory problems or asthma can also experience health effects from ozone exposure, such as coughing, throat irritation, chest tightening, pain, burning or discomfort when taking a deep breath and shortness of breath.

### Clean Air Action Day

Mayor Rob Franke proclaimed June 22, 2018 as Clean Air Action Day, calling upon the community who live, work and play in Cedar Hill to incorporate clean air actions into their daily routines or organizations to improve air quality such as working from home, carpooling, biking or walking instead of driving, avoiding vehicle idling, conserving water and electricity, reducing travel during rush hour, and postponing lawn mowing.

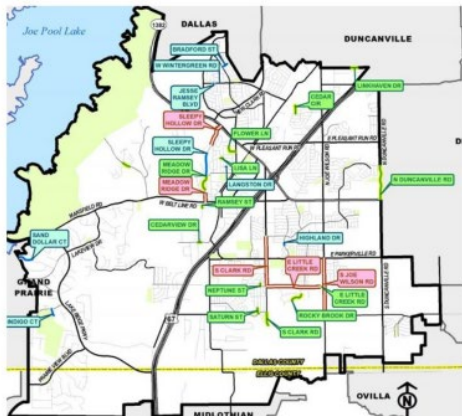

## STREET CONSTRUCTION RAMPS UP FOR SUMMER

This summer, street crews and contractors are working hard to complete asphalt and concrete repairs and preventative maintenance throughout the city.

This fiscal year, the City will spend about \$1.5 million on street projects, which represents a significant increase from prior years. This increased investment in critical infrastructure is based in part on citizen survey results, which identified maintenance of streets and facilities as one of the top three community priorities for Cedar Hill. # Environmental Collection Day

- Cedar Hill's Environmental Collection Day provides household hazardous waste collection, electronic waste collection and secure paper shredding services all in one day. ECD is hosted quarterly in partnership with CHISD. ECD encourages actions that align with ANT values. ANT outreach is given to all residents attending the event. ECD pulls staff across multiple departments including Code Enforcement, Signs, Streets, Water Operations, Parks & Rec, Fire, Environmental, Engineering, Building Maintenance & Building Inspections. The Fire Department Youth Academy's Explorers Program helps with the e-waste and shred.

# Sustainability tours & International partnerships

- Cedar Hill is a regional leader in Environmental Sustainability and regularly provides building tours of the Government Center. The Cedar Hill Government Center is a LEED certifiable building with 480 solar panels, wind turbines & EV charging stations. In addition, Cedar Hill was the first in Texas to switch all City water meters to “smart meters” at once, providing real water usage data to residents and promoting water conservation.
- Cedar Hill partnered with ICMA and hosted 3 YSEALI professional fellows from Vietnam and Malaysia to learn about environmental sustainability. A key component to the 4-week fellowship included learning about Cedar Hill’s adoption of clean air policies and how adoption of such policies could potentially impact their respective countries.

## CEDAR HILL *Proclamation* OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cedar Hill is a leader in environmental protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cedar Hill is a regional partner with Air North Texas, a regional public awareness campaign and partnership through the North Central Texas Council of Governments that seeks to improve air quality in North Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the ten counties in North Texas including Dallas County fall under nonattainment for the pollutant ozone, according to the Environmental Protection Agency, impacting economic development in the region; and

**WHEREAS**, children, older adults, people with lung disease, and people with heart disease make up about two out of every five residents of North Texas and are most vulnerable to the effects of poor air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, while air quality is improving in North Texas, regional air pollution levels were considered moderate or worse on more than a quarter of the days in 2016, according to the Air Quality Index; and

**WHEREAS**, we are all stewards of our air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, Air North Texas has designated the first Friday of summer as a day to foster long term behavioral changes across the region to help us all breathe cleaner air and build healthier communities in North Texas;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Rob Franke, Mayor of the City of Cedar Hill, Texas, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 22, 2018 as

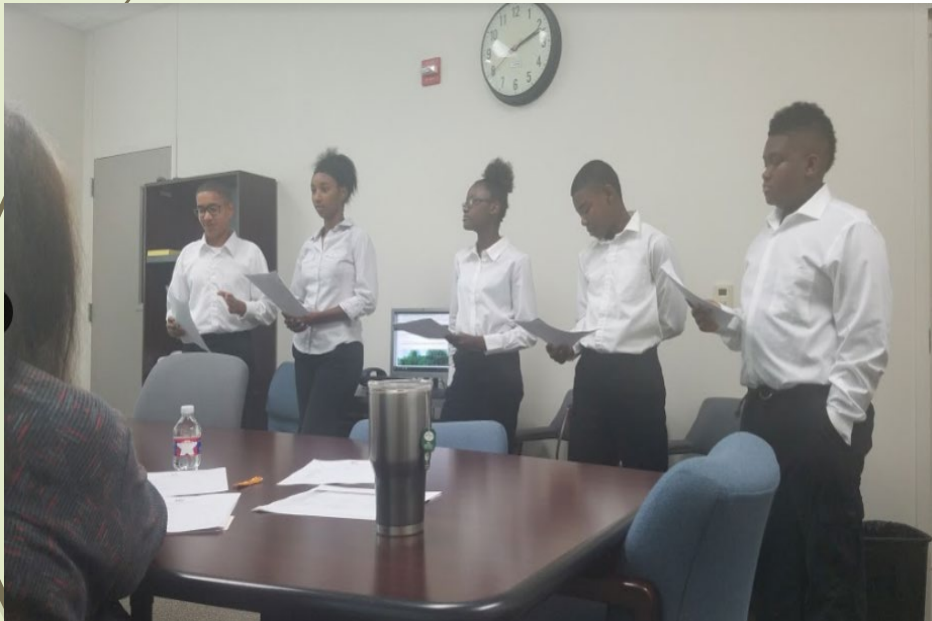

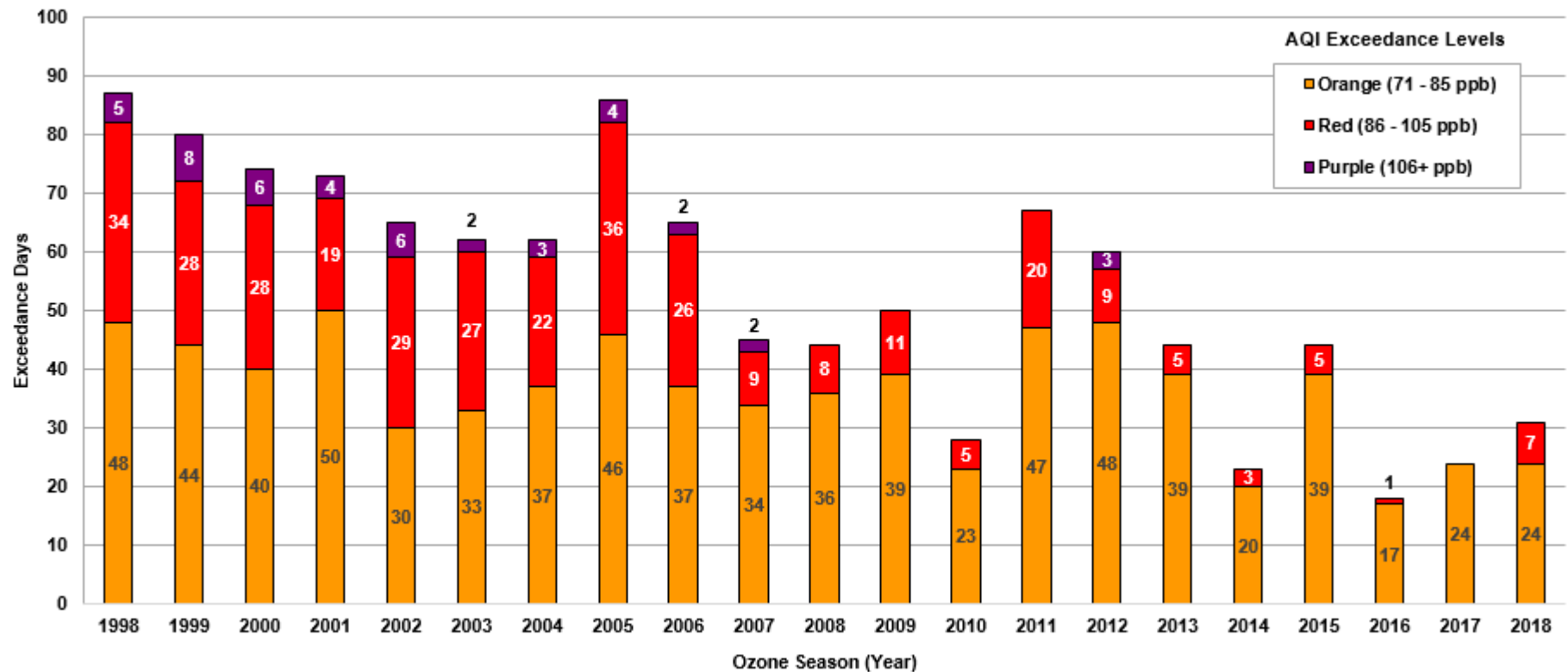

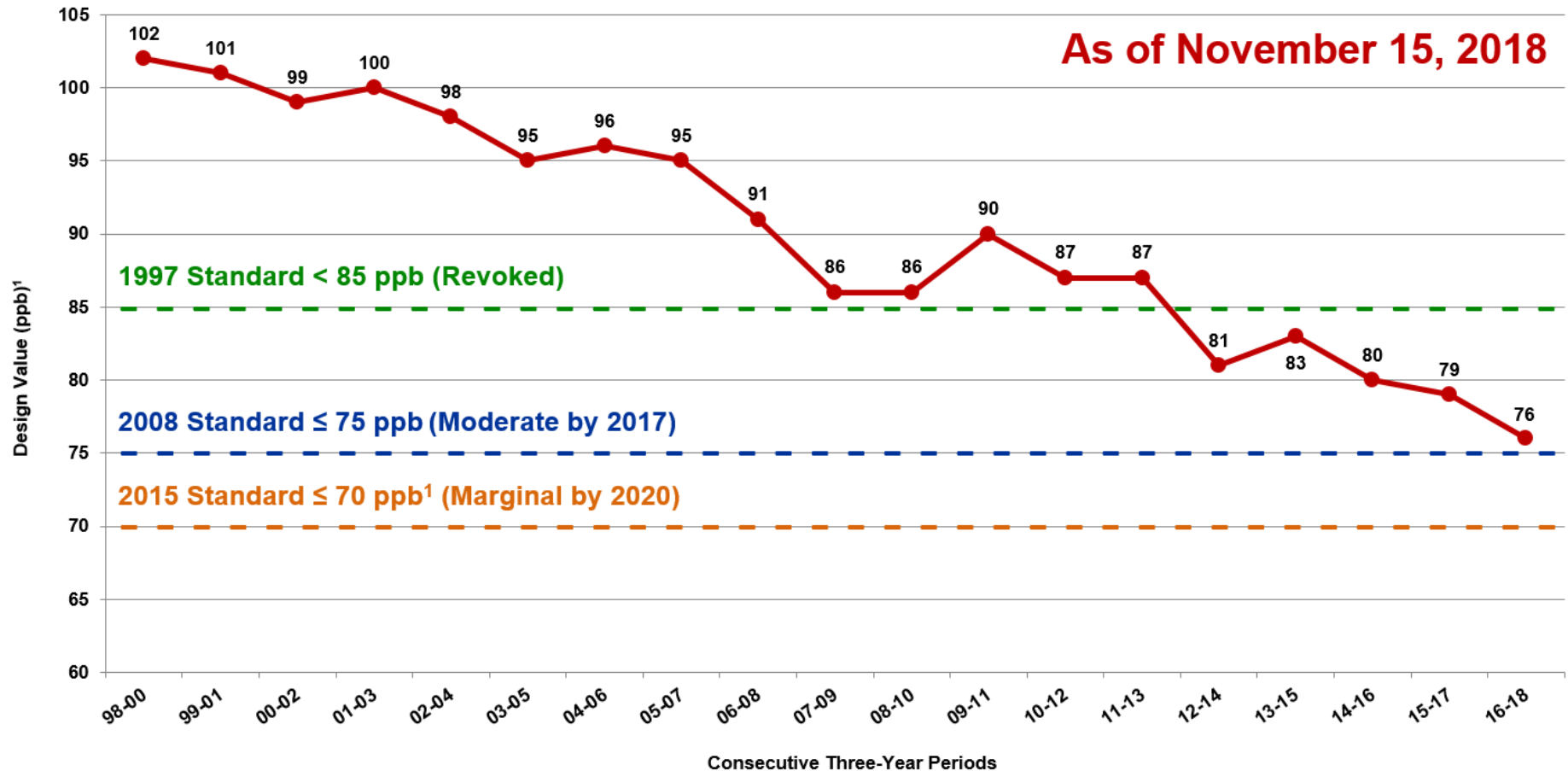
# 8-HOUR OZONE NAAQS HISTORICAL TRENDS

Based on  $\leq 70$  ppb (As of November 15, 2018)



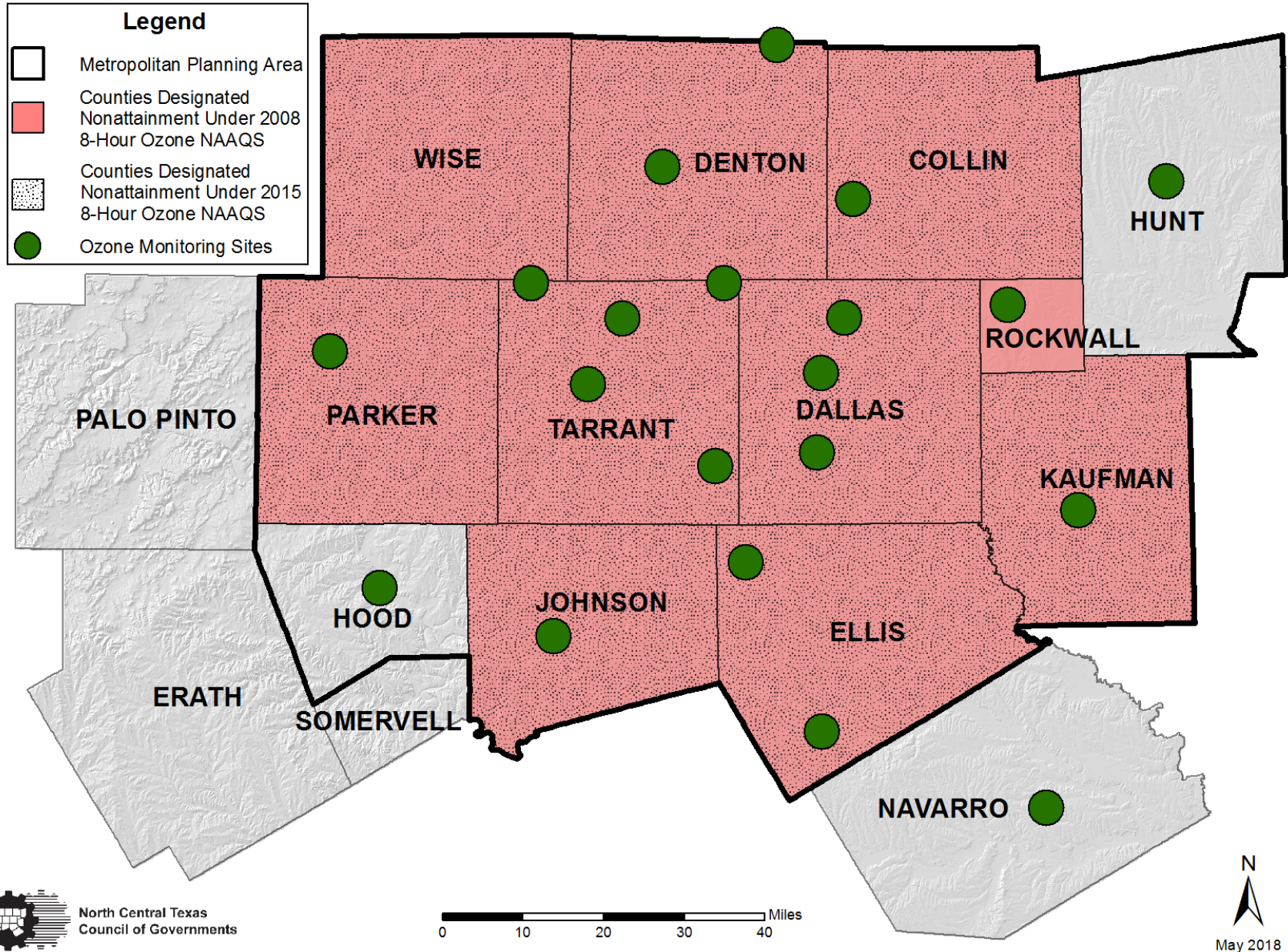


# 8-HOUR OZONE NAAQS HISTORICAL TRENDS

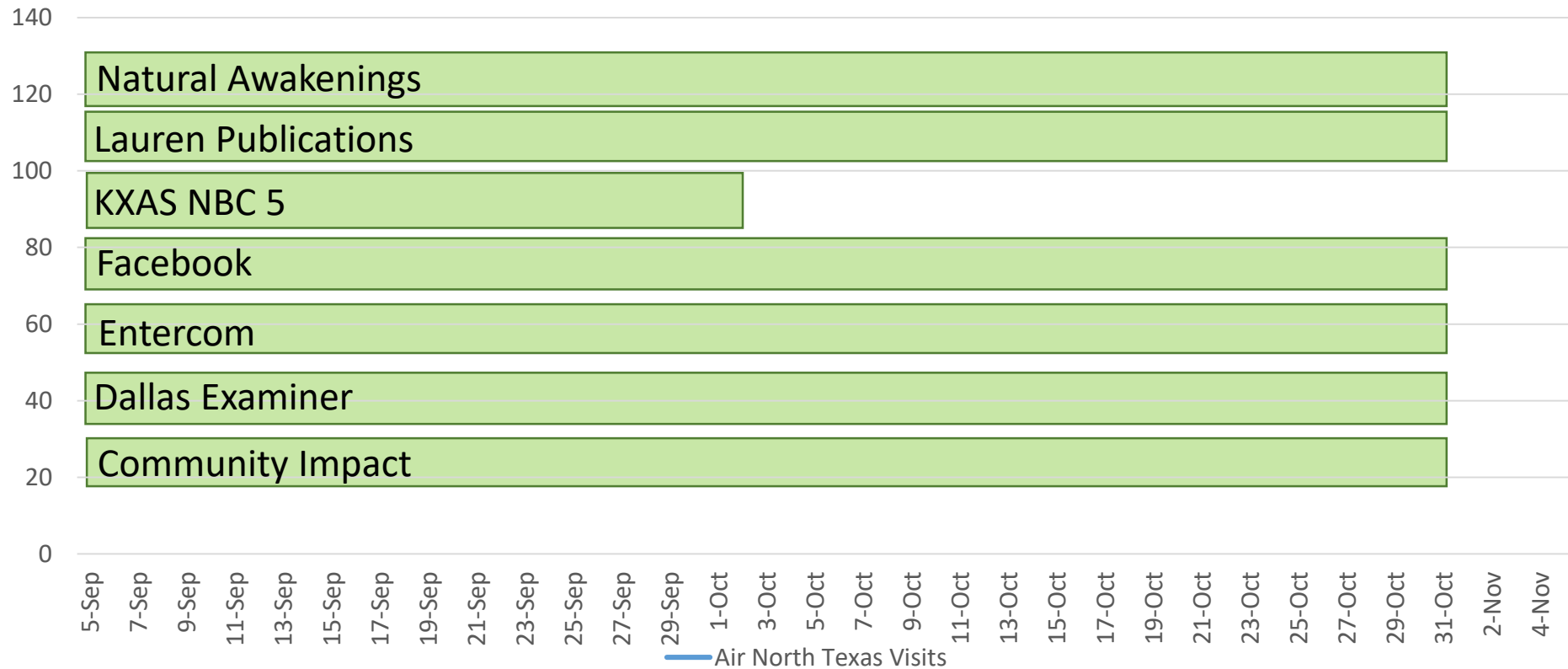

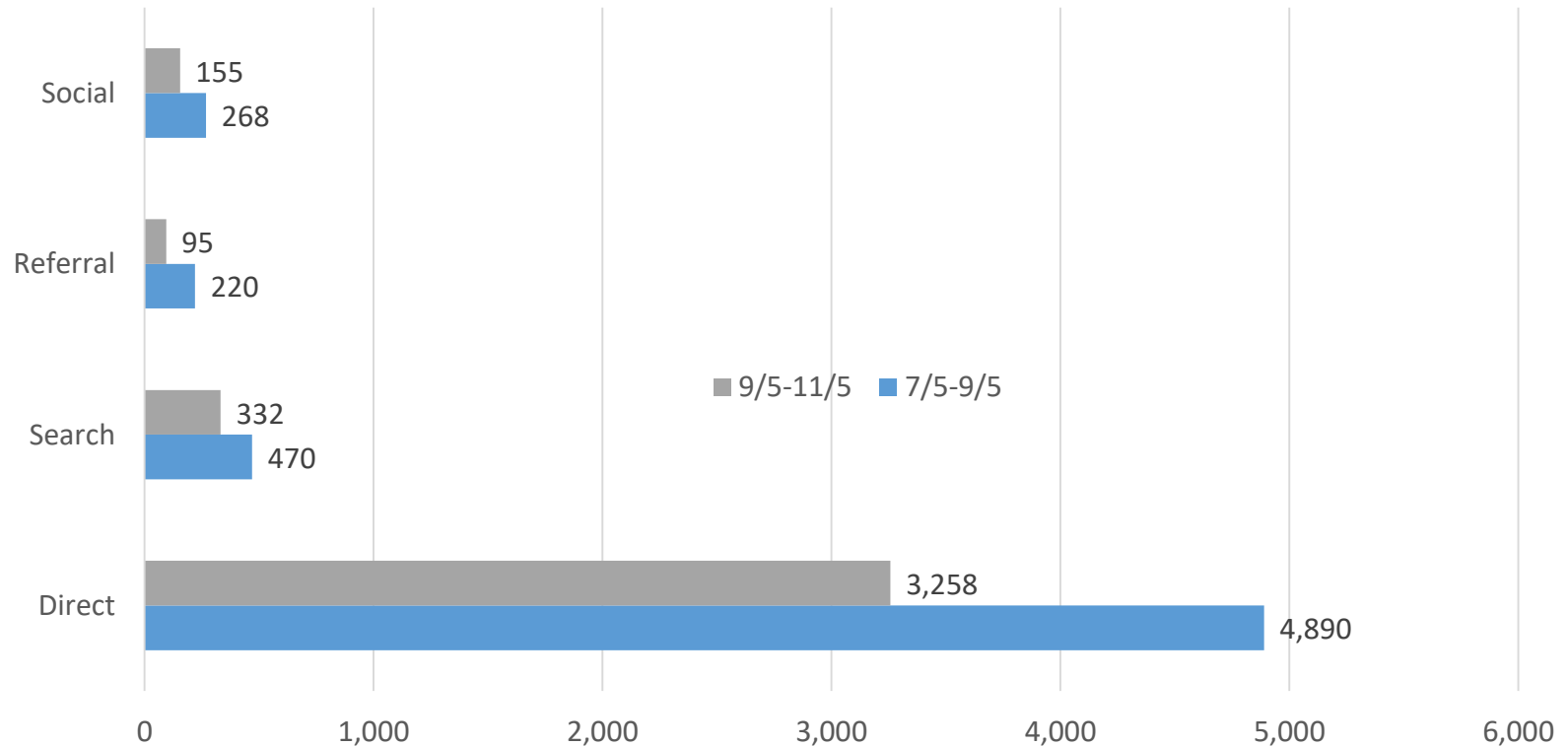

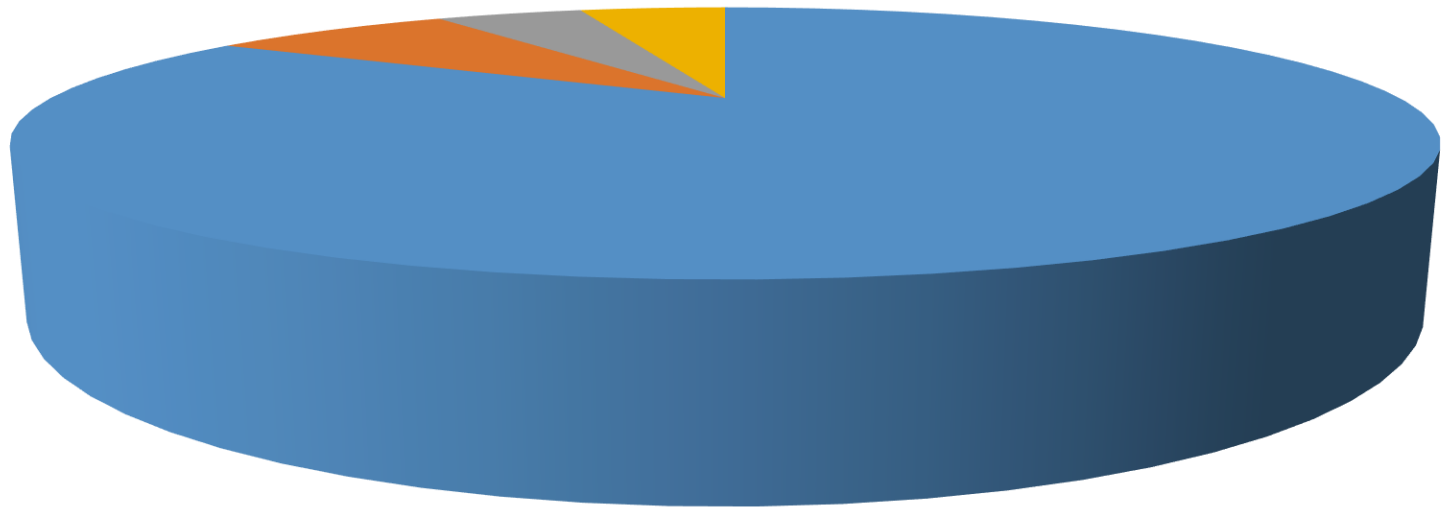

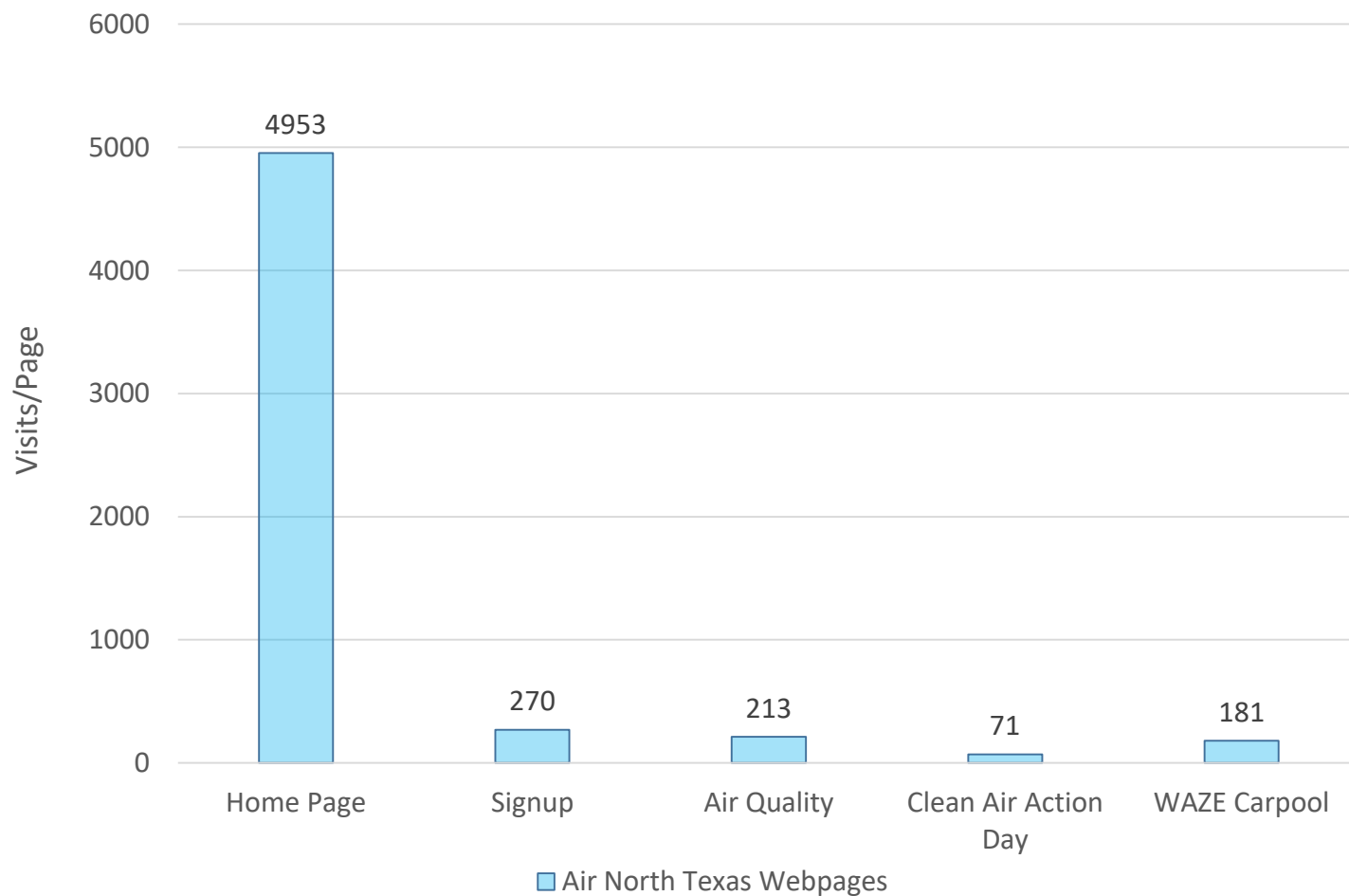
