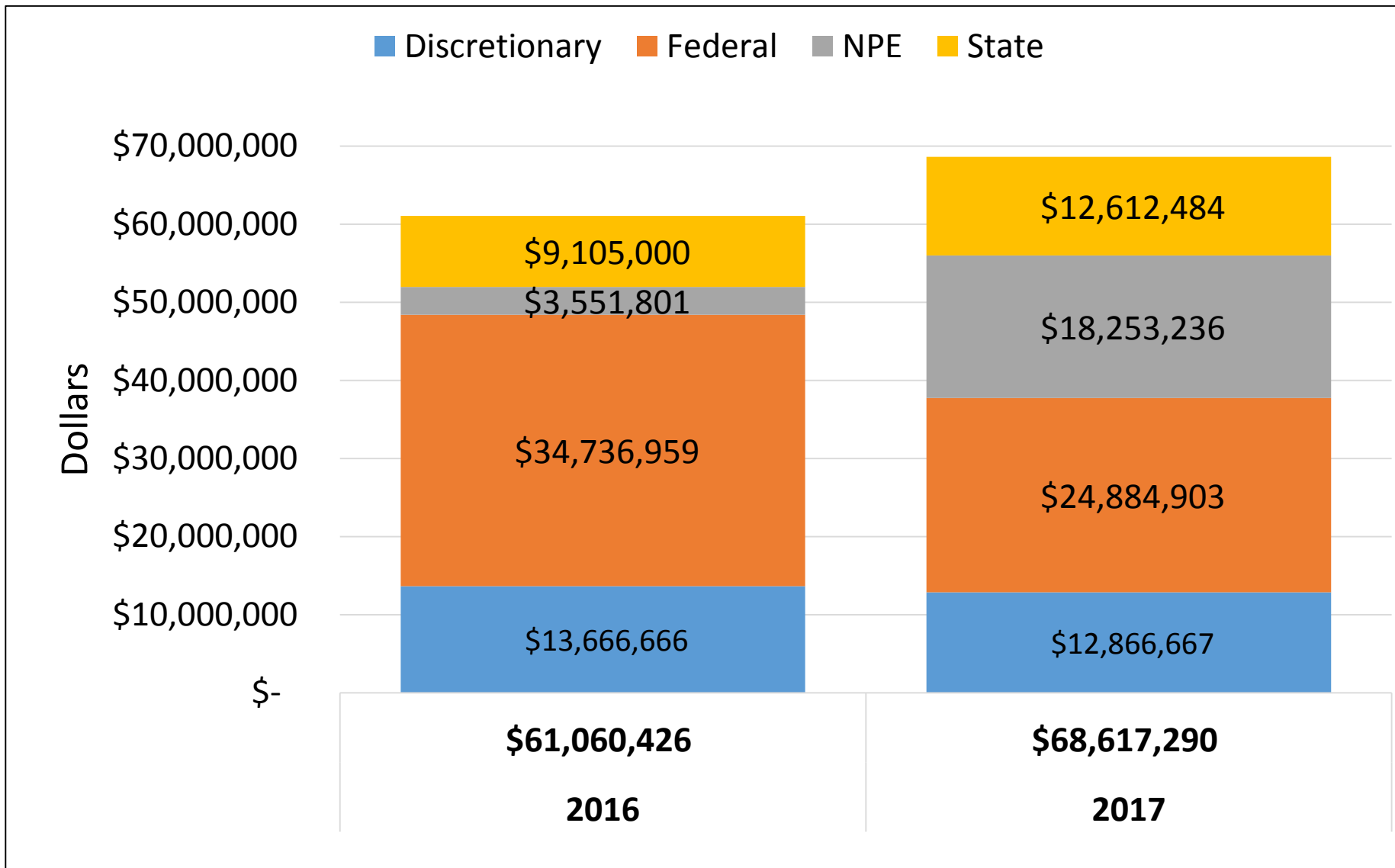

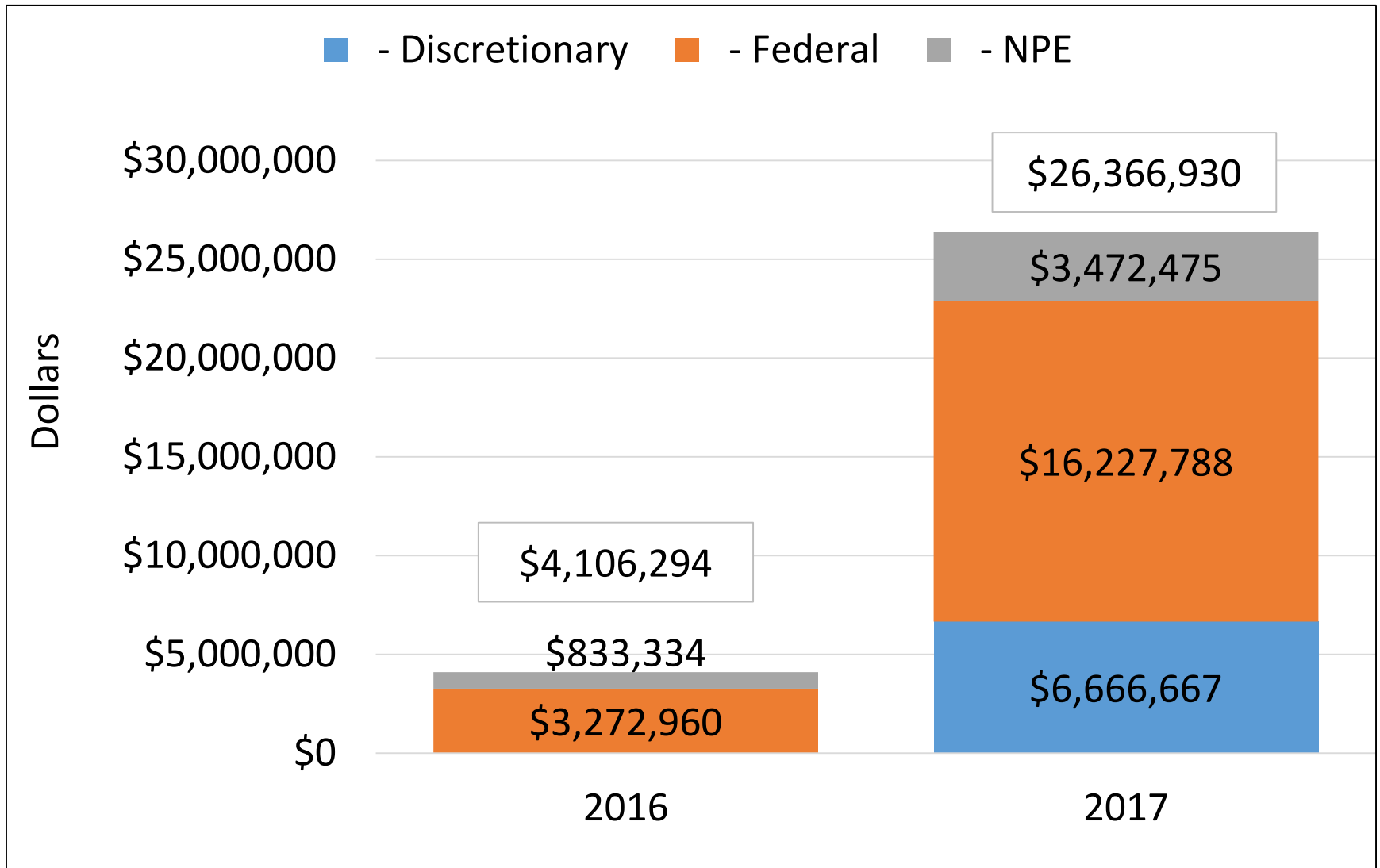

Introduced December 18, 2017

“A bill to create opportunities for women in the aviation industry”



FINDINGS

Women are more than 50% of the national workforce.

YET ONLY

- 2% - airline mechanics
- 4% - flight engineers
- 6% - pilots
- 26% - air traffic controllers
- 18% - flight dispatchers
- 5% - repairmen

Are women.



OBJECTIVES

- Identify discouraging industry trends
- Coordinate functions to facilitate support for women
- Create scholarship opportunities for women in aviation
- Enhance aviation training, mentorship, education, and outreach programs
