KEY MESSAGES

- It's all about options for drivers who want a more reliable commute. North Texas transportation leaders have worked collaboratively over the last decade to build transportation projects to keep up with the growth and fuel economic development and prosperity in our region.
- **Drivers can choose to pay a toll for a reliable trip with predictable travel experience.** They can save time getting to their destination with speeds generally 50 mph or greater, or they can drive at no cost in the adjacent, non-tolled general highway lanes. Drivers can make the best choice for them based on their own needs each time they're on a roadway with TEXpress Lanes.
- **TEXpress Lanes lower the stress of commuting.** TEXpress lanes are separated from the general highway lanes and have fewer entrance and exit ramps, so weaving and merging is reduced. TEXpress Lanes also allow you to "skip the line" in the non-tolled general highway lanes with a more reliable commute.
- Using TEXpress Lanes produces far-reaching benefits. As TEXpress Lanes attract more users, traffic speeds have been shown to increase on general highway lanes with less congestion, as well. And TEXpress Lanes are only added to the most congested corridors in the Dallas-Fort Worth region.
- TEXpress Lanes are easy to use. Dedicated entrance and exit ramps guide you safely on and off each
 segment, and prices are clearly marked at each entrance ramp so that you can decide if you want to
 pay the toll to take the TEXpress Lanes. You can visit www.TEXpressLanes.com before your trip to

- TollTag, TxTag or EZ Tag customers and carpoolers get the lowest toll rates. Tag customers receive
 reduced rates on TEXpress Lanes. And, tag customers who carpool (HOV 2+) receive free or
 discounted travel on area TEXpress Lanes. They simply need to download the GoCarma mobile app,
 which uses Bluetooth technology to automatically verify customers are part of a carpool.
- Payment for driving on TEXpress Lanes is easy, too. Drivers choosing the TEXpress lanes will pay
 their tolls through one of two easy methods, electronic or pay-by-mail. The NTTA provides customer
 service and billing for area TEXpress Lanes. Tolls will be deducted automatically from TollTag, TxTAG
 or EZ TAG accounts or billed through NTTA's ZipCash video pay-by-mail system.
- Corridors with TEXpress Lanes have been improved or completely rebuilt. The rebuilt corridors
 include frontage roads, bypass lanes, non-tolled highway lanes, and tolled TEXpress Lanes. Drivers
 have the choice each time they travel which lanes are right for them. Plus, on LBJ Express and North
 Tarrant Express, operations and maintenance costs are paid by the private sector, rather than relying
 on gas tax funding.
