
VOLKSWAGEN SETTLEMENT OVERVIEW

FUNDING FOR EV INFRASTRUCTURE

Volkswagen Settlement Texas Mitigation Plan: Zero Emissions Vehicle Infrastructure – OPENING SOON

Funds: The purchase and installation of new light-duty electric vehicle Level 2 charging equipment

\$10.4 million in grant funding will be available for **reimbursements** of up to \$2,500 per installation

Grants will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis and may not exceed the following percentages of eligible costs:

- 70% for Publicly Available EV Chargers
- 60% for EV Chargers at a Workplace or Multi-Unit Dwelling

Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Tax Credit

Funds: A Tax Credit equal to 30% of costs of EVSE, not to exceed \$30,000

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
Deadline: Installed before December 31, 2020



STEP 3: Identify New EV Station Locations and Partners to Fill in Charging Gaps and Apply for Funding for Installation



GET EVSE IN YOUR WORKPLACE OR MULTI-UNIT DWELLING

STEP 4: Connect with your workplace multi-unit dwelling management to request on-site infrastructure and share details on funding opportunities

FUNDING FOR EVs

Texans can save up to \$10,000 on qualified EVs



Federal: Qualified Plug-In Electric Vehicle Tax Credit \$2,500 - \$7,500 **Texas:** Light Duty Motor Vehicle Purchase or Lease Incentive Program <u>Up to \$2,500</u> Utility: GreenSense EV Incentive Program (offered for Denton Municipal Electric customers) Rebate of \$300
